Aston Martin DB5 J



A 66% scale rendition of the 1963 DB5 Cabriolet, this piece pays homage to one of the most beautiful and iconic cars in history. It is also one of the first three prototypes crafted by Hedley Studios, adding to its exclusivity.

Ferrari Testa Rossa J



This 75% scale, fully electric replica of the 1957 pontoon-fendered 250 Testa Rossa racing car is the most collectible of Hedley's creations. It celebrates Ferrari's rich legacy with impeccable craftsmanship and zero-emission technology.

Bugatti Baby II



Inspired by the 1924 Bugatti Type 35 Grand Prix car, this 75% scale model features a genuine solid silver Bugatti Macaron and is built to exacting standards. Each Bugatti Baby II is hand-built and strictly limited in production, making it a true collector's item.

Every Hedley model is hand-crafted by skilled artisans, with each piece uniquely numbered, signed by the artist, and equipped with an official chassis plate from the original automotive manufacturer. Beyond their aesthetic appeal, these models are powered by zero-emission electric propulsion systems, underscoring Hedley's commitment to sustainability.

Customization options allow collectors to personalize their models, ensuring that no two Hedleys are alike. Produced at 66 – 85% scale, these drivable models encapsulate the essence of automotive history while embracing modern, eco-friendly technology.
